RESOLUTION NO. 3

A RESOLUTION of the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of Kitsap County Sewer District No. 7, Kitsap County, Washington, to establish a monthly service charge per unit for the use of existing sewer lines and providing penalties and a discount.

Section I. Service Charge. In order to provide funds for the initial organization of the District office, repair and maintenance of sewer lines and purchase of necessary equipment, a service charge will be made as follows:

Service Charge

Classification of Users

Monthly rate

Residence, apartments, house trailers

\$3.50 per unit

Business, Class 1, (less than 3 persons)

2.00 per unit

If a business is maintained in connection with a residence, the business rate plus the residence rate shall apply.

Section II. Service Charge Payments. Service charge payments are due and payable prior to the first day of the month for which billing is issued. If the service charge is not paid when due it becomes delinquent and a penalty of ten per cent thereof shall be added to the delinquent charge.

The monthly rate shall be charged for a unit that is occupied eleven or more days per month.

A discount of five per cent shall be allowed for all payments of service charges made six months in advance.

Section III. Billing. Billing of service charges shall be made to the owners of property for which sewer service is being furnished.

Section IV. Vacancies. If in lieu of the months advance

payments the property owner notifies the District that the unit or units will not be occupied for at least eleven days of the ensuing month no service charge will be made for that month.

If a property owner who has paid six months charges in advance notifies the District that a unit or units will not be occupied for at least eleven days during a month, credit shall be allowed for that month.

Section V. Liens. An accumulation of four months service charges and penalties for a unit shall be cause for the District to certify the delinquencies to the Treasurer of Kitsap County, Washington. These charges and penalties added thereto and interest at the rate of eight per cent per year shall be a lien against the property upon which service was received.
