RESOLUTION No. 85- 2

WHEREAS, the District has a requirement to make certain improvements to its collection system and install a wastewater treatment facility, and;

WHEREAS, the District has been instructed by the Washington State Department of Ecology to make these improvements, and to prepare an E.P.A. Facilities Plan, and:

WHEREAS, the District does not have funds available to pay for said Facilities Plan while continuing operation of the existing system and maintenance of the existing system;


THEREFORE, BE IT NOW RESOLVED, that the District must raise funds for this purpose in the calendar year 1986, or resort to deficit financing;


THEREFORE, the Board of Commissioners has deemed appropriate to operate on a current basis to avoid deficit financing, and to impose a Special Assessment for the year 1986 to fund these required projects.


BE IT NOW RESOLVED, that to accomplish the purposes outlined above the Board of Commissioners has resolved to maintain the current sewer service rate of ten dollars per month ( \$10.00) per residential unit, and;

To impose a Special Assesment for the year 1986 of fifteen dollars per month ( \$15.00) per residential unit, effective January 1, 1986.
