

KITSAP COUNTY SEWER DISTRICT No.7

RESOLUTION No. 86 - _____

WHEREAS, the District has been directed by the WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF ECOLOGY to terminate the discharge of raw sewage into PUGET SOUND immediately,

and WHEREAS, the most cost effective method of terminating this raw sewage is to install a primary treatment and chlorination facility,

and WHEREAS, said facility will of necessity be of limited capacity, only capable of treating the domestic sewage in the District collection system,

and WHEREAS, the treatment of storm water will be excessively expensive and will require capacities several times larger than the planned facility;

it is THEREFORE RESOLVED, that steps must be taken to limit and/or eliminate storm water presently entering the collection system by the following methods:

1. Sources of storm water such as roof drains and downspouts which currently enter the District collection system must be terminated by the responsible property owner by December 31,

2. Sources of stormwater through floor or basement drains in abandoned or unused buildings that are not protected from rain and snow by sound roofs in good repair are to be terminated by Decmeber 31, 1986.

3. All collection and/ or interceptor sewer lines which no longer serve residences presently occupied will be terminated by the District before December 31, 1986.

4. In the event any property owner fails to take appropriate and timely action to terminate storm water inflows as prescribed in paragraphs 1. and 2. above, the District will intervene to terminate the inflow and will charge the owner all legal, engineering, inspection and construction costs in addition to a fine of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) for each and every violation.

Be it further RESOLVED, that the effects of this RESOLUTION and/ or fines under the terms of this RESOLUTION may be appealed before the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS. Persons wishing to appeal must file a written statement outlining the reasons for the appeal with the Secretary, C. L. Spier, 1939 Park View Drive N. E., Bainbridge Island, WA. 98110, before December 31, 1986. The BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS may grant relief based on the written appeal, or grant a hearing, or dismiss the matter as without merit.
