A RESOLUTION of the Board of Sewer Commissioners of Kitsap County Sewer District No. 7, Kitsap County, Washington, adopting standards, rules and regulations for the construction and installation of sewer extensions.

WHEREAS, the Board of Sewer Commissioners of Kitsap County Sewer District No. 7, Kitsap County, Washington ("District") desires to adopt standards, rules and regulations for the construction and installation of sewer extensions; now, therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SEWER COMMISSIONERS OF KITSAP COUNTY SEWER DISTRICT NO. 7, KITSAP COUNTY, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1: The District adopts (1) the "Sewer Extension Manual and Agreement" attached as Exhibit "A" to this resolution and (2) _____ attached as Exhibit "B" to this resolution, as the minimum standards, rules and regulations of the District for construction and installation of sewer extensions.

Section 2: The District's engineer is authorized to approve variances to the standards, rules and regulations adopted in Section 1 that are in the public interest, based upon sound engineering judgment or necessary to resolve ambiguities or conflicts in the standards, rules and regulations.

Section 3: Any acts made consistent with the authority and prior to the effective date of this resolution are hereby ratified and confirmed.


