RESOLUTION 96 -2

WHEREAS, this District will soon be changing its methods of collection and treatment of sewage as its new facilities come on line, and;


WHEREAS, the expenses of operating and maintaining these new facilities will be substantially different from the cost of providing sewer services in the past, adjustments need to be made in the revenues to support of these services;

THEREFORE, the District hereby cancels the monthly assessment of \$25.00 designated as a "Special Assessment" used to defray the capital costs associated with preparing the Comprehensive Plan and EIS, and will change the monthly sewer service fee from \$10 to \$35 which will not increase the monthly cost to those properties presently actively connected which will remain at \$35, and;

Commencing with <sup>M+O charge</sup> May 1, 1996, the District will levy a charge of \$20 a month to defray the cost of operating its new general facilities such as the treatment plant and pump station against those properties with an assigned connection but not yet physically connected until such time as that "assigned" connection is activated, at which time, those properties will be charged whatever regular monthly service rate is for active connections in force at that time.
