RESOLUTION NO. 97 - 1

WHEREAS, this District has found it necessary to impose a 'holding fee' or 'reservation fee' of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per month in order to keep generally used facilities such as the treatment plant, outfall and pump station operateing so that they will be available in the future when new connections are made, and,
WHEREAS, the District took action on this matter by enacting Resolution 96-2 on the 15th day of March, 1996, imposing the \$20.00 per month fee on those who desired to have a connection reserved, and,
WHEREAS, the District must have prompt and continueing payment of these fees in order to defray Maintenance and Operation costs in a timely manner, and
WHEREAS, it is necessary for the District to have some means of discontinueing to hold reservations for connections for those who do not pay these fees in a timely manner,

THEREFORE, the District will no longer hold reservations for those who are six (6) months delinquent in paying the Twenty Dollar (\$20.00) per month 'reservation fee', will so notify those who are delinquent and allow them thirty (30) days after such notification to pay the delinquent fees and late charge penalties in full, and
IN THE EVENT the forementioned fees and penalties are not paid in that thirty day (30) 'grace ' period, the District will cancel the connection reservation and return it to a pool of reservation to be awarded to those desiring a connection on a 'first-come-first served' basis, and

ANY PROPERTY OWNER who shall have a reservation cancelled for non-payment shall not be entitled to a connection until all delinquent amounts have been paid from the date the reservation fee was initiated up to the date the connection is made.
