RESOLUTION 97 -10


WHEREAS, the District incurs expenses for the inspection and administration of 'side sewers' connecting sewer mains with buildings on private property, and


WHEREAS, it is necessary for the District to carry out said inspections employing a qualified person in order to assure the District that such 'side sewers' will properly conduct sewage without permitting the inflow or infiltration of stormwater or pollution of adjacent soils through leakage, and


WHEREAS, it is necessary for the District to have accurate and complete records of the locations, depth, etc. of said 'side sewers',

THEREFORE, the District must have some method of defraying the cost of inspections and administration and to provide for these services and for this purpose the District will levy a charge of \$50.00 (Fifty dollars) for each side sewer connected to its mains, this amount to be paid prior to inspection. In addition, the District shall charge fees of \$50.00 (Fifty dollars) per hour for consultation, plans and actual physical inspection of said side sewers as requested by the property owner. It shall be incumbent upon the property owner to notify the District when the installation is ready for inspection prior to final connection to District mains.

Minutes of Meeting

A regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners was convened at 7:30 pm, June 13, 1997 at 1939 Park View . In attendance were Commissioners Spier and Bourlier. District property owners were in attendance: Mary Fujioka, Susie Fujioka, Ed Klewada and Wes Edens.

Minutes of the preceding meeting were read and approved.

Vouchers were approved.

Resolution 97-8 regarding a proposed renewal of the US Bank loan with the District to make quarterly principal payments of \$1000 each, raising interest to 5.95 and authorizing Mike Yuhl to sign for the District was approved.

Mr. Klewada and the Fujioka sisters reiterated that they did not want sewers and asked if under the circumstances they could be relieved of any obligation from the ULID#1 assessments. The District said it would have to consult its bond attorney about this.

There was some discussion of the need to create an inspection/administration fee for installations of side sewers and to establish a policy relative to late comers fees and how these would be related to 'reservation fees'. A proposed formula was worked out and the Secretary instructed to prepare a resolution.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at approximately 9:25 pm.
