

KITSAP COUNTY SEWER DISTRICT NO. 7
RESOLUTION #2001- 1

WHEREAS the District, by law, is required to hold monthly public meetings, and the nearest publicly owned facility--if the space is available when the District needs it--is at Port Blakely School, which is 3-3/4 miles from the central part of the District, and

WHEREAS lack of parking and a suitable room prevent meeting at the treatment plant site, and

WHEREAS in the past, meetings have been held in the homes of the Commissioners, which imposes an undue restriction on the Commissioners, as at least one must always have a home large enough and available for every monthly meeting, and

WHEREAS this poses a burden on the public because, while the meeting is the second Thursday of the month, its location has not always been consistent due to Commissioner illness, vacation, business, etc.; and the location has also not always been accessible in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, and

WHEREAS the District has looked for a location that is central in the District and at a location where people could walk to the meetings, and has determined that the area between Parkview, Evergreen and Fort Ward Hill Road is the most centrally located part of the District. The availability of nearby parking, along with ADA accessibility are also considerations, and

WHEREAS the District uses are infrequent and, therefore, the facilities should be dual use that would benefit the community, such as community center, day care, etc., and such dual use would survive if the District is acquired by the City, and

WHEREAS Lot #1 in Block #3 has been selected as the most feasible site for such a use;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the District proceed to purchase the vacant property identified as Lot #1 in Block #3 in the Plat of Fort Ward Estates Division #2.
