

KITSAP COUNTY SEWER DISTRICT NO. 7

Resolution #2001-2

A resolution setting forth conditions under which the District could offer to provide sewer service to owners of single family homes, where such homes are outside of the boundaries of an area covered by an interlocal agreement. Such service may be offered if every one of the following conditions are met.

- 1) The septic tank/drainfield system is destroyed by natural causes such as landslide, earthquake, or flooding more than 1 ft. deep for an extended period of time;
- 2) The loss of the septic system has caused the health officer to post the home as not fit to occupy;
- 3) The house is vacated;
- 4) The City has, or will approve, the connection to a City sewer;
- 5) The owner pays all fees and charges owed the District; and
- 6) Either one of these two conditions in Resolution #98-4 is met:
  - a) The proposal will correct or alleviate an existing water pollution problem, such as raw discharge or failed septic system, etc., or serve to prevent a future such occurrence, or
  - b) The proposed sewer service must have a clear benefit to the general community, such as permitting additional open space by permitting clustering of homes.
