Resolution 2008-2

**A Resolution regarding changes in billing
for Serenity House**

WHEREAS Tax Lots 042402-1-002-2008, 042402-1-003-2007, and 042401-1-006-2004 in the Lynwood Center area of Bainbridge island are now in use for a boarding house for up to 19 disabled adults in a building called Serenity House; and

WHEREAS Kitsap County Sewer District No. 7 has received a request from the Kitsap County Consolidated Housing Authority, which manages Serenity House, to reconsider the number of connections for which it is billing Serenity House; and

WHEREAS RCW 35.83, The Washington State Housing Cooperation Law, in Section .010 states "...it is a proper public purpose for any state public body to aid any housing authority operating within its boundaries or jurisdiction or any housing project located therein, as the state public body derives immediate benefits and advantages from such an authority or project; and that the provisions herein after enacted are necessary in the public interest"; and

WHEREAS Serenity House currently has 19 residents living in its facility;

WHEREAS the District has determined that the average wastewater flows from 19 disabled adults and support staff are equivalent to the wastewater load from 4 single family dwellings;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Commissioners of Kitsap County Sewer District No. 7 reduce the number of connections for monthly billing purposes to 4 connections, so long as the property is used for the purpose of housing up to 19 disabled residents. The District shall also inform the City of Bainbridge Island that the sewer fees for this property should be reduced to 4 monthly sewer fees.
